

Compac Drum Handling Specification

Drum Handling Clamp – Forward Tipping – Motorised, Geared or Manual

The forward tipping clamp attachment offers forward rotation of drums, barrels or vessels with manual, geared or motorised forward tipping.

The drums are securely gripped by pads on the external diameter with a handwheel providing the clamping and unclamping actions. This mechanism has a torque limiter fitted so that the pads do not over or under tighten and minimise the possibility of any drum distortion. A second handwheel provides the geared forward tipping motion for the emptying of the drum.

The motorised solution features both powered clamping and powered forward tipping. The forward rotation mechanism is operated via a pendant control, which is mounted to the handlebars of the 'Compac' drum handling equipment.

The machine is entirely suitable for the food industry and other hygienic applications.

The attachment is backed up by a full bespoke design service so ensuring that the right solution can be made to suit most drums.

All Packline attachments are fully interchangeable and can be easily fitted or removed from any model of Compac lifting machine that is fitted with the attachment quick release system.

The attachment can lift loads up to 200kg however, larger capacities, and to suit a variety of drum diameters, are available on request.
